Tá Gaelscoil Philib Barún ag glacadh páirt i dtionscnamh Comenius. Is éard atá i gceist le Comenius ná tionscnamh Eorpach ina ghlacann scoileanna ar fud na hEorpa páirt ann. Is iad na tíortha atá i gceist ná An Ghearmáin, An Íoslainn, An Tuirc agus An Bhreatain Bheag. Mairfidh an tionscnamh seo ar feadh 2 bhliain agus 'sé teideal an tionscnaimh ná 'Respect: Think Globally, act Locally' Sa chéad bhliain pléimid cé chomh thábhachtach is atá sé chun meas a leiriú dúinn féin, dár gclann agus dár gcairde. Sa dara bhliain, díreoidimid ár n-aighe ar mheas a léiriú don thimpeallacht agus don domhain ina gcónaí.

Is iad príomhchuspóirí an tionscnaimh seo ná

- Tuiscint ar mheas a fhorbairt agus a chur i bhfeidhm ar daltaí gur bunchloch cumarsáide é is cuma cárbh as duit.
- Tuiscint ar shaoránachas a fhorbairt, idir shaoránachas Éireannach agus Eorpach.
- a chur ar chumas an pháiste ómós a thabhairt d'éagsúlacht dhaonna is cultúir agus nádúr idirpleách an domhain a chiallú agus a léirtheiscint.
- Aird a dhíriú ar fhreagrachtaí na bpáistí i gcomhthéacs domhanda.

Tá an tionscnamh fite fuaite le chéile le snáithaonaid an churaclaim OSPS agus Tíreolaíochta ach go háirithe, cé go mbeidh comhtháthú i gceist leis na hábhair uilig chun an tionscnamh a chur i gcrích. Part of a lifelong Learning programme, Comenius seeks to develop knowledge and understanding among young people and educational staff of the diversity of European cultures, languages and values. It focuses on the first phase of education from pre-school and primary to secondary schools. Over the next 2 years Gaelscoil Philib Barún will be participating in a Comenius project with four other European schools. These schools are in Iceland, Germany, Wales and Turkey. The title of this project is 'Respect; Think Globally, act Locally'. The focus is on developing an understanding of citizenship among students; making students aware that they make a difference in the world and helping them understand that respect is the pillar of communication.

During the first year the students will acquire knowledge of how important it is to respect oneself and from there on how important it is to respect family, friends and schoolmates. During the second project year the term respect will be expanded and the focus turned to how important it is for us to respect nature and the world we live in and that every little thing we do does make a difference to the environment.

The main objectives of this project are

- To understand what respect means and to realise that it is a basic pillar of communication regardless of where one comes from.
- To develop a sense of citizenship, Irish and European.

- To enable the children to show respect for the diversity of peoples and cultures and to realise the interdependent nature of the world.
- To develop the children's sense of responsibility in relation to their role in the world.

This project is linked closely with the SPHE (Social, Personal and Health Education) curriculum but the project aims to successfully integrate all of the subject areas. 'By his own [recent admission](#), the Minister for Education clearly has a whopping €386m of unspent funding at his disposal. More than enough to build a new school for Gaelscoil Philib Barún and for many, many others too.

However, for reasons known only to him and his department, our school is left languishing among [1,178 other schools awaiting major capital works](#). This is not only depressing (considering we've been asking for a permanent school for over 24 years) but also shocking when you consider how many other schools are in the same situation as we are.

The mere fact that €386m of budgeted

money remains unspent is not only a crime against our children but also a crime against thousands of construction workers facing very tough and uncertain times at present. The Minister has confirmed that the money will indeed be spent but he did not say when, where or how.
